

Arriving by car

Parking is available at South Bar, the West side of North Bar, Calthorpe Street Car Park and Castle Street Multi-story Car Park. As of August 2013, parking is available at £3.50 for the day.

From M40 Junction 11

Follow signs for **Banbury A422** and then the **town centre**. Pass Castle Quay on the left, and then follow signs for **Wroxton (A422)** and the Multi-Storey. At Warwick Road junction, turn left for **Chipping Norton A361**. Parking is available as described above.

Arriving by train

Banbury railway station is served regularly by services from Birmingham, London, Oxford and Reading. A direct service is also available from Bournemouth, Manchester and York.

From the railway station, proceed to Bridge Street, following signs for the Town Centre. Continue across a junction and bear left at the Town Hall onto the High Street. Continue for some ways up the High Street to Banbury Cross, turn right onto Horse Fair and find the St Mary's Centre down a drive to the right, just before the Church of St Mary the Virgin.
